APA Citation Style - Cornell University Library

APA citation style refers to the rules and conventions established by the American Psychological Association for documenting sources used in a research paper. APA style requires both in-text citations and a reference list. For every in-text citation there should be a full citation in the reference list and vice versa.

In-text citation: the abbreviated version of the full reference to your source material. Typically, an in-text citation includes the authors last name and the date of publication (see examples throughout this document for variations). In-text citations are generally located at either the beginning of a sentence or at the end of the information

In-Text Citation Format When you are including a citation in the body of your paper, use the following format. Do not use this format for the citation list at the end of your paper. Short Quotations - Include the Author’s last name, the year of publication, and the page number you are quoting from. Introduce the quotation with a phrase like
